Tunstall Parish Council

Tunstall Parish Council meet on the second Wednesday of every other month, starting in January. We meet in the Committee Room of the Community Centre (see page 4 for further details).

Our meetings start at 7.00pm and usually last 2 hours maximum. Although all Parish Council meetings are technically 'closed', i.e. members of the public are not permitted to speak, we do hold an 'Open Public Forum' at the beginning of each meeting where we welcome and encourage comments from residents. You are of course very welcome to stay for the whole meeting to hear the debates and discussions.

The Parish Council is made up of 9 Councillors plus the Clerk who acts as the 'Proper Officer' and 'Responsible Finance Officer'. If you would like to contact the Parish Council, please use either of the following methods:

Tunstall Grapevine

Tunstall Parish Council also run the 'Tunstall Grapevine'. This is an electronic news distribution service. Once you have signed up you will receive notifications of missing cats, road works, planning applications and any other information the Parish Council feel may be of interest to residents.

Bins and Recycling

The litter bins are collected by SC Norse (a subsidiary of Suffolk Coastal District Council) every **Tuesday** in the centre of the village and at Tunstall Common (*Blue and Brown Bin one week and Grey the next*) and every **Wednesday** in the Snape Bridge area.

You will find glass recycling facilities at the Community Centre (entrance on Ashe Road behind the Green Man). If you notice the bins are getting full, please call SC Norse on 01394 444000 to report that they require emptying.

Tunstall's Churches

The Parish Church of St Michael and All Angels

Tunstall's parish church is on Orford Road next to Tunstall Hall. St Michael's is part of the group of 6 parishes including Orford, Iken, Sudbourne, Chillesford, Butley.

Sunday services at Tunstall are usually at 11am on the second, third and fourth Sunday each month. Details are displayed in the Tunstall Bulletin and in the church porch.

The church is open every day from 10am until at least 3pm in winter and 5pm in summer and welcomes visitors and Tunstall residents to enjoy this historic building which also offers free superfast broadband Wifi and refreshments.

The church is looked after by the PCC and a very small group of volunteers from the village who keep the church open and tended for everyone to use. New helpers are always welcome.

In addition to weekly services to which all are welcome, there are other services and activities such as the hugely popular traditional candle lit Carol Service on Christmas Eve, Lent lunches in the church, an annual barbecue and Harvest Supper. A programme of occasional concerts and performances in the church aim to generate funds for "Raise the Roof" fund for church roof repairs.


Tunstall Bulletin

Public Transport


Trains

Tunstall Common

Tunstall Common itself is a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI), a beautiful fragment of the ancient sandling dry lowland heath that was once extensive across this area of coastal Suffolk. It lies next to Tunstall Forest, which was started in the 1920s as a pine plantation.

In the Great Storm of 1987, Tunstall Forest lost thousands of trees and the opportunity was taken to diversify the mix of trees planted. The area of the Common has been designated an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and is a haven for wildlife, including fallow deer and muntjac.

The Common is managed through a High Level Stewardship Scheme with Natural England and work is undertaken by local contractors and volunteers

On the Common during 2013 we were very lucky to see a Parrot Crossbill, very rarely seen in this country and a credit to the recent land management that has been undertaken.
