

## Tunstall MUGA Terms and Conditions for use

**We want everyone, of all ages, to be able to enjoy using our community's MUGA court.  
We ask you to help us look after the facility so that everyone can continue to enjoy  
using it for years to come.**

1. All members must register online agreeing to the Terms of Use prior to use or hire of the pitch. Parents/Guardians of under 18's must register on their behalf and ensure they fully understand the Terms of Use.
2. All users of the MUGA must observe all up to date guidance relating to protective measures in respect of the Covid 19 Pandemic (please refer to Covid-19 additional terms of use).
3. Bookings (per session) are for 55 - or - 115 minutes, finishing 5 minutes before the hour to ensure the court is cleared and free ready for the next booking. We do ask if you are using the facilities that you vacate the court if a timed slot comes up or a pre-booked user arrives.
4. Members/parents/guardians/club leaders are responsible for the conduct of their members or players and must make sure they abide by the Terms of Use for using the facility.
5. Players will not intentionally damage the MUGA in any way. Users will be liable for any damage caused where the Committee considers the damage is not fair wear and tear.
6. Opening hours are 09:00 to 21:00. Please do not use the MUGA outside of these hours.
7. After play, the tennis net and posts must be returned to the storage area unless the next players have arrived and confirmed they will be playing tennis and they will remove and store.
8. Inappropriate behaviour (no foul or abusive language within the court), vandalism or misuse must be reported immediately to one of the MUGA Management Committee.
9. The court has a special surface suitable for the sports provided, only clean rubber soled footwear should be worn. Boots with steel studs and/or blades are strictly prohibited.
10. Spectators are requested to also wear appropriate footwear if entering the Games Area.
11. Roller skates, roller blades, skate- boards, scooters and bicycles must not be taken into the court.
12. No smoking on court.
13. No chewing gum, food, or drink to be taken on to the court.
14. Strictly no glass to be taken inside the MUGA court.
15. No litter, mud, or debris to be left on the surface.
16. No chairs or similar to be put in the court.
17. No animals are allowed in the court.
18. No attempt should be made to use the court when there is ice on the surface.

19. Do not climb on the fencing, framework, goals, or nets.
20. Anyone using the MUGA or surrounding areas do so at their own risk, liability will not be accepted for personal injury or the loss or damage of valuables.
21. It is strictly forbidden to sub-let the facility.
22. Identification must be produced upon request by a MUGA Management Committee member when using the facility.
23. Groups using the court must have a designated first aider and are responsible for the supply of their own first aid kit.
24. In the event of any accident, or injury sustained by a user of the court a report must be made to the MUGA Management Committee ([tunstallmuga@gmail.com](mailto:tunstallmuga@gmail.com) or 01728 687484)
25. The MUGA may be closed at the discretion of the Committee.
