

Tunstall MUGA Aims and Goals

The goal of the Tunstall MUGA Club is to provide a multi-use sports facility for our community, encourage the creation of new village sports teams/clubs including coaching for our younger residents and to generally help our community keep fit and healthy.

The MUGA court is available for tennis, netball and 5-a-side football and basketball. It can be booked through the Booking Facility on the Tunstall Website (<https://tunstall.suffolk.cloud/amenities/multi-use-games-area/>).

Initially use will be open to members of our community, sports clubs, and registered users from outside of our community. The facility will be free to use by Tunstall residents, the purpose being to ensure the maximum opportunity for our community to use this exciting new facility.

From 17th May 2021 Covid-19 regulations stipulate that groups must not exceed 30 people outdoors and that all users must adhere to current Government Covid-19 guidance. Only members of our MUGA Club and guests accompanied by those members may use the facility. All members agree to our Terms of Use by placing a booking. This is to ensure everyone who uses the court is aware of how to look after our community's facility so that everyone can continue to enjoy using it for years to come.

The court is located on the playing field at the rear of Caulfield's Garage in Ashe Road, Tunstall and can be accessed from there via Duck Lane, which is located behind the Green Man Public House.

The MUGA has a lighting facility which is controlled by a timed switch, which will cease to activate after 21:00hrs to respect our local residents. When not in use the facility will be locked using a padlock with a code. The code number will be changed frequently with the new code advertised to Club members on a regular basis. The MUGA will remain locked between the hours of 21:00 and 09:00 each night, again to respect our local residents.

Bookings are made in 1-hour slots, starting on the hour, for example 11:00-12:00. The maximum number of back to back bookings is two which would give two hours play, for example 13:00-15:00 this must include time for setting up and cleaning down.

Advance bookings can only be made up to 6 weeks in advance. If there is a requirement beyond this, please contact the Admin team.

Initially the court is free to use only by individual members of our community with their friends, family, and guests. Those outside our community who wish to use the facility will be welcome to do so but at a fixed rate fee of £10.00 per hour.
